



Announcing the 2024 Rocky Mountain Guitar Camp Dr. John Knowles, CGP Scholarship Program

Through a generous gifts, concerts and matching donations we are delighted to offer scholarships to aspiring young guitarists to attend the 2023 Rocky Mountain Guitar Camp August 4-8, 2024 at the Hilton Garden Inn, Olde Town Arvada, CO

Criteria:

- Applications are limited to individuals who are no older than 21 by August 1 in the year of Camp.
- Applications from those who have received 3 previous awards will not be considered
- Applicants must complete the application form and submit a 250 word statement of career aspirations and what they hope to gain by attending RMGC
- Applicants must have a fundamental understanding of chord structure and knowledge of the fingerboard
- Applicants must submit three videos of performances 90 seconds to 3 minutes in length (or links there to) demonstrating proficiency as described below
- Scholarship will cover full on site costs of participation. All awards will be applied directly to the cost of participation Awardees may be reimbursed for travel expenses according to the guidelines on page 2
- Scholarship awardees are expected to participate fully in all aspects of the Camp

Video Performance Guidelines:

- Videos can be home, live, or studio recordings.
- Sound quality of featured musician must be clearly audible (video quality is not a factor).
- Recordings of the performances should be recent (within the last year).
- Editing or overdubbing of your performance in any way is not permissible.
- The three videos should be in a similar style with contrasting tempos.

TRAVEL AWARD GUIDELINES

Through generous donations and fund raising efforts RMGC is able to offer travel funds for Dr. John Knowles, CGP Scholarship winners according the following criteria.

- **Out of State Travel:**

For those flying to RMGC, travel will be reimbursed up to a maximum of \$500. Receipts are required. For those driving to RMGC, mileage will be reimbursed at \$.50/mile or the cost of around trip airfare from the nearest airport, which ever is less.

- **Colorado in State Travel:**

For those driving to RMGC, travel will be reimbursed at \$.50/mile up to a maximum of \$500.
